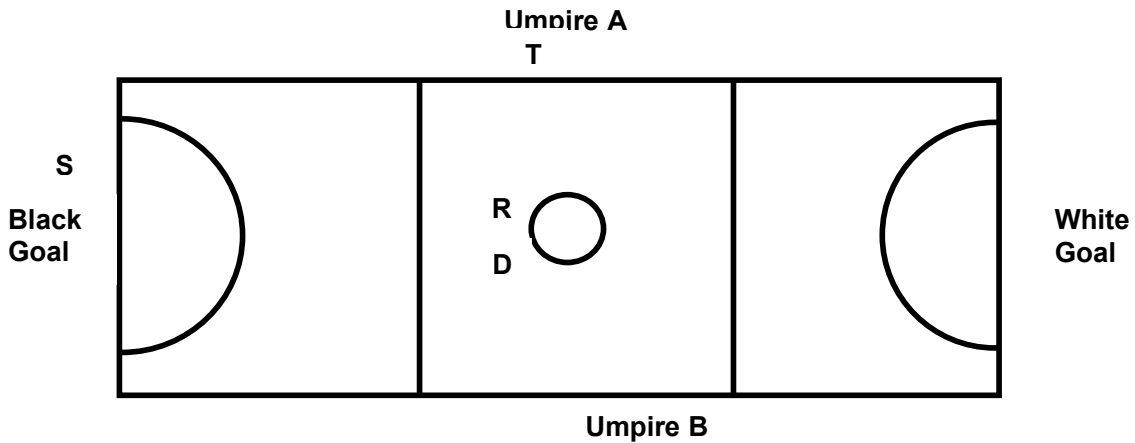

Similarly, it is NOT necessary to specify that the Umpire must blow the whistle when penalising an infringement.
