15 players per team will be named after Trial 2. All players will attend the Noho Marae with the final 12 selected players named at first training on 7th March 2010.

Player Dispensation:

Players MUST attend BOTH trials. Players who are not able to attend a trial (due to a **vital** reason) must have requested dispensation IN WRITING from the TMHP Executive **by 26th November**. All players who have requested dispensation and received approval from the TMHP Executive will have their name and details forwarded to the appropriate Team Officials at the first trial. Player's who have not requested dispensation and turn up to the 2nd trial, will not be eligible to trial.

Player Eligibility:

Players & Team Officials must meet the following criteria to be eligible to trial or officiate for TMHP:

- Resides in Counties Manukau regional boundary, **or**
- Plays netball or officiates at a Netball Centre within the Counties Manukau regional boundary
- Must be under the age of the grade they wish to trial for as at 1st January of the year of the tournament ie; if you are trialling for U13 grade, you must be 12 years or under as at 1st January 2010 for the Pacific Challenge Tournament. If you turn 13 years after 1st January 2010, you are eligible to trial.
