The Services:

The National Emerging Talent Selection Panel will be responsible for the identification, player profiling and selection of national squads and teams underneath the Silver Ferns, through the attendance at key events as agreed with the National Player Development Manager.

Key accountabilities

- Have input into the selection of the NZ Under 21 Squad and Team, Emerging Talent Accelerant Group and NZ Secondary School Squad and Team as required.
- Provide player profiles on National Squad players and update existing profiles regularly throughout year.
- Assist in the identification and profiling of new talent at all levels from the NZSS Championships through to the Perry Foundational National Netball Championships.
- Work with other selectors and National Squad coaches to ensure adequate positional cover – succession planning for Silver Ferns, in other squads.
- Observe and report on identified trends - either regionally or nationally specific.
- Attend training opportunities offered by national sport service organisations as agreed with the National Player Development Manager.

Emerging Talent Selectors may also be required to be available to promote netball in the media and with Netball New Zealand's sponsors, including providing media comment along with other Netball New Zealand personnel and attending promotional activities.
