



NEW WORLD NETBALL VOLUNTEER AWARDS

NEW WORLD WOULD LIKE TO SAY THANKS TO THE VOLUNTEERS WHO HAVE GIVEN THEIR TIME FOR YOUR LOCAL NETBALL CENTRE.

Last year, we gave away **\$50,000 IN NEW WORLD GIFT CARDS** to netball volunteers all over the country to 'say thanks' for their time and hard work towards netball in their community.

We enjoyed rewarding those who helped out so much, we thought, why not do it again in 2010.

So, be it the canteen team, the umpires or the person who cuts the oranges, we at New World think they deserve a big pat on the back. That's why we're asking team members, coaches, supporters and anyone else involved in netball to nominate the volunteer they think is most deserving, because these people won't nominate themselves.



SIMPLE STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS.

STEP 1

SET UP VOTING BOX

This box is the information destination for the awards. It includes a step-by-step guide to voting, the nomination forms, and the nomination form entry box. Set this up in a high traffic area of your netball centre and make sure you have some pens handy around the unit.



STEP 2

ATTACH NOMINATION FORMS

Place these forms near the entry box, or to attract more nominations, try something different like handing them out with the team cards or include them in your newsletters.

The nominator can even write a brief description of what the volunteer has done to deserve the award. Then you can attach these forms on to the Award Winner's letter so they can see how much they are appreciated by their local netball community. If your netball centre needs more nomination forms don't hesitate to call your regional manager.

STEP 3

PUT UP POSTERS AND BANNER

Included are some A2 posters and a vinyl banner (if you have asked for a new one) for you to place around your netball centre. They will be a great way for your netball community to find out about the awards programme and encourage people to vote for their favourite volunteer.

STEP 4

SELECT THE WEEKLY WINNERS

Empty your nomination box at the end of each week and choose the volunteer you believe deserves recognition. The aim is not necessarily to award the most popular volunteer, but the most deserving for that week. But we leave this decision process up to your discretion. However we do ask that you ensure a different person is awarded each week. If nominations are slow during the early weeks of the season, we welcome your choice of a worthy recipient.

STEP 5

NEW WORLD GIFT CARDS

Included in your kit will be at least ten* winners envelopes with the New World \$25 Gift Card and Award Winner's letter enclosed within. Send these letters to winning volunteers throughout the winter netball season. This season we have made a small change to the process and now ask that winners register their Gift Card number at www.newworldnetball.co.nz in order to make the card live. That way we are not sending out cash in the mail. If the winner does not have access to the internet we welcome your assistance to this stage of the process by registering their card for them, or alternatively you or the winner can call Margaret O'Sullivan at Foodstuffs on 09 621 0620. We have also included this information in the Award Winner's letter.



STEP 6

ANNOUNCE YOUR WINNERS

You can announce your winners by writing their names on the winners list sheet included in your pack. Put this list up on a notice board around your netball centre, announce winners over the PA, or even mention the winners in your club newsletter. If you have any further questions on how the awards programme works, don't hesitate to call your regional manager for more information.

New World really appreciates all the support from your netball centre in implementing this programme, and we hope it helps to give something back to your community netball volunteers.

So get started today by kitting out your netball centre and let all those volunteers know how much they are appreciated.
