



## Applications NZ Secondary School Team Coach & Assistant Coach

Applications are now being called for the NZ Secondary School (NZSS) Team Coach and Assistant Coach. This has been a highly successful step in the National player pathway for developing elite players at Secondary School level and is an important part of the NNZ High Performance programme.

Applicants for both roles will be completing Modules through the NNZ Coach Development Framework or have equivalent coaching qualifications. Experience coaching developing elite players is also essential and ability to utilise sports code and/or video analysis is desirable.

The successful applicants will be highly organised, well planned and reliable, able to work closely with other National Squad coaches to ensure a co-ordinated approach to elite player development. Other competencies required are extensive netball knowledge, the ability to give and receive constructive feedback, decisive and objective under pressure.

These contracted positions will require the successful applicants to be available for the Regional Secondary School Tournaments held between 30 August - 3 September 2010, NZ Talent Development regional sessions Oct - Dec 2010, NZSS Team Trials - April 2011, NZSS Camp May 2011 and the Trans Tasman Secondary School event to be held in New Zealand in June 2011.

The NZSS coach will also be part of the National Emerging Talent Selection Panel attending the Lion Foundation Netball Championships, October 2010 and the NZ Age Group Champs 2011.
