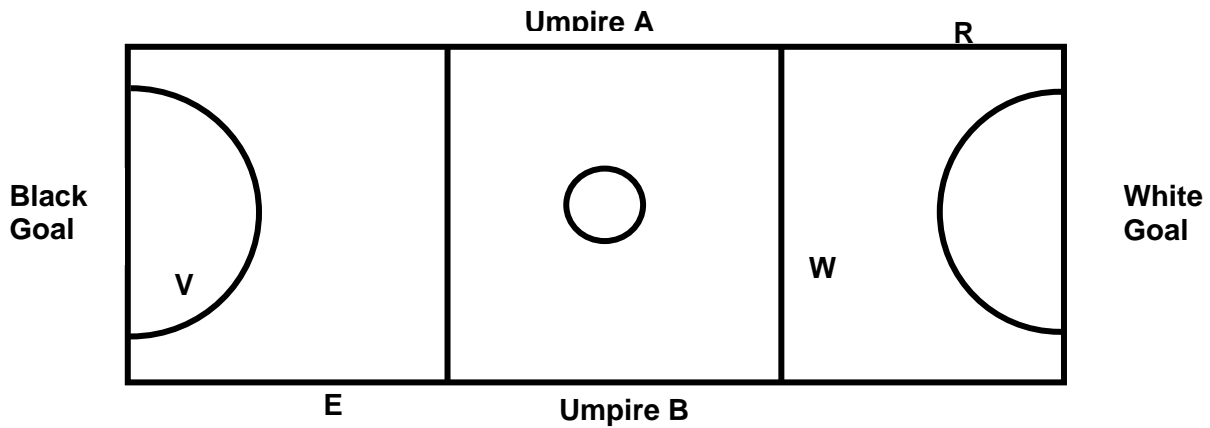

Note: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> It is NOT necessary to specify that the infringer must stand beside and away from the player taking a Penalty Pass or Penalty Shot. Similarly, it is NOT necessary to specify that the Umpire must blow the whistle when penalising an infringement.
